

The Maryland Sheep & Wool Festival is a much anticipated annual event for shepherds, knitters, spinners, dyers, felters and other fiber and animal enthusiasts. Each year the Festival offers a portfolio of workshops for the fiber art and shepherding community of the Mid-Atlantic as well as Festival goers from across the United States and even Europe.

The Festival is always the first full weekend in May. Our workshops will begin the Wednesday prior to the festival and run through the Sunday of the festival. Workshops focus on fiber preparation, spinning techniques, dyeing, knitting, felting and weaving of fibers with an emphasis on wool. Workshops are 2-day, 1-day or 1/2-day in length.

MSWF pays an honorarium for teaching workshops. The teachers' travel (booked by teacher in accordance with contract terms), shipping costs up to \$100, lodging and meals on MSWF workshop dates are also paid for by the Festival.

Factors considered when choosing workshops and teachers may include:

- Popular new or advanced techniques for fiber artists
- Representation of basic or beginner techniques
- Proposed equipment and space needs
- Teacher experience / qualifications
- Demand for specific class or teacher
